

This is with reference to the query raised by your circle whether the setting up of $2^{nd}\ BB$ kiosk per rural exchange is permissible or not.

In this relation it is clarified that the obligation of one kiosk per rural exchange is the minimum requirement laid down by BSNL-USOF agreement. Hence BSNL is free to install $\dot{kiosk}(s) \ beyond \ the \ rollout \ obligations \ i.e. \ one \ kiosk \ /rural \ exchange \ but \ these \ kiosks \ would \ not$ be eligible for subsidy from USOF.
