Subject: Introduction of limited usage VDSL Broadband Plans with Higher Upload Speed – reg.

It has been decided by the Competent Authority to **introduce the following limited usage VDSL Broadband Plans with higher upload speed.** The tariff for these plans has been prescribed as follows:-

- The monthly charges for modems will be the same as circulated vide this office letter **No. 64-03/08-Broadband dated 18.02.2010** and their sale price will be the same as circulated vide this office letter **No. 64-03/08-Broadband dated 15.07.2010**.

4. Features of the above plans should be clearly spelt out to the customers to establish its distinction (i.e. **higher upload speeds**) vis-à-vis existing VDSL plans, so as to obviate any avoidable migration of customers from higher value plans.
5. All other relevant terms and conditions shall be same as per the earlier circulars.
6. This circular is issued based on the approval of Competent Authority in Broadband Cell File No. 64-56/09-BB/Pt.3. 7. These instructions shall **be effective from 15-06-2012 in all the circles.**
