Kind attention is invited to the above referred letters issued from this office regarding eligibility of the subsidy for the USOF, non –USOF tariff plans, CPE and PCs.

It has been brought to the notice that the field units are unaware of the eligibility of the various items like offering only two USOF subsidized tariff plan i.e. BBG Rural USOF 99 and BBG Rural USOF 150 to rural /remote customers under the USOF scheme which is leading to the lesser acquisition of the customers. Hence the eligibility of the various items which attract subsidy is reiterated below for dissemination of the information to all concerned officials:

- 1. Tariff to be offered under USOF for broadband subsidy
  - a. As per the USOF agreement and subsequent clarifications, subsidy is admissible for net 31 broadband connections per DSLAM covered under USOF agreement, provided on USOF subsidized tariff plan i.e. BBG Rural USOF 99 and BBG Rural USOF 150 or other non -USOF broadband plans i.e. all broadband plan including all rural plans having minimum speed of 512 Kbps and without any charges towards installation, registration, security deposit and modem. (intimated vide (i)).

### 2. CPE subsidy

- a. Vide (iv) above, approval of USOF was conveyed for extension of subsidy for CPEs provided to individual and institutional connections provided under the agreement on net addition basis upto maximum 63 CPEs per DSLAM.
- b. For every connection where CPE subsidy is to be claimed, the CPE subsidy has to be passed on to the subscriber by the way of free ADSL Type –I modem or by way of a rebate of Rs 850/- in case of CPE of higher specifications.

- 3. Computer subsidy
  - in accordance with the crause 14.7 of pure 1 21-00 BDC Doroll HSOF 99 and agreement. ( intimated vide (iii) )
  - c) It is applicable on net addition basis, limited to a maximum number of 31 per DSLAM, as per clause 2.3 of USOF agreement dated 20.01.2009.
