Kindly find enclosed PMR report for the month March-2012. On perusal of report, it is observed that number of BTSs having accumulated down time >24 Hrs in a month are quite large, specially for AP-54, AS-89, BR-120, HP-128, JD-32, J&K-58, MH-23, MP-171, TN-37 & UL-22. Immediate attention is required by circles to minimise down time of BTS's. The circle wise details for parameters which are not meeting TRAI set BM in report are as given below:

- ▶ BTSs accumulated downtime (not available for service in %age)(TRAI BM <=2%):- BTSs accumulated downtime in respect of Assam, Bihar, Chhattisgarh, J&K & NE-II Circles are 9.4, 15.3, 3.4, 8.8 & 2.6 respectively.
- ➤ Worst affected BTSs due to downtime in %age (TRAI BM <=2%): Immediate attention is required by the following circles to minimised accumulated down time of BTSs.

- ➤ Worst affected cells having more than 3% TCH drop (Call drop) rate (%age)(TRAI BM <=5%): Worst affected cells having more than 3% TCH drop rate in respect of UP(W) circle is 8.1.
