## Thottathil B. Radhakrishnan, J.

The learned counsel for the petitioners seek an adjournment. The contesting respondents oppose this request by stating that on the strength of the interim order of stay of operation of the order issued by the Tribunal, steps are being taken to effect promotion on the basis of the seniority list which has been quashed by the learned Tribunal. We see that there is a direction to recast the seniority list. Obviously, the stay of operation of the

Tribunal's order would mean that there can be no recasting of the seniority list for the time being. However, we think that the interest of both sides can be maintained if no promotions are effected until otherwise ordered by this Court. We record the submission on behalf of the Department that there would be no administrative stalemate if promotions are not effected. It will be open to any of the parties, including the establishment to bring up this matter if any further clarificatory orders are necessary.
