6.5.R.788-In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 307 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the ollowing rules regulating the method of recruitment to the Telegraph Engineering Service Class II in the Posts and Telegraphs Department, namely:-

THE TELEGRAPH ENGINEERING SERVICE (CLASS II) RECRUITMENT RULES, 1966

- 1. Short title and commencement:- (i) These rules may be called the Telegraph Engineering Service, Class II Recruitment Rules, 1700.
- (ii) They shall come into force on the date of their
- Definitions:-In these rules, unless the context therwise requires;
- (a) 'Department' means the Indian Posts and Telegrohs Department.
- (h) Director General' means the Director General of Posts and Tele, phs.
- (c) 'Government' means the Central Government.
- (d) 'P&T Board' come Lie Coall and Telegraphs Board.
- (e) 'Service' means the Telegraph Engineering Service, (Class II).
- 3. Application: These rules shall apply to the posts as specified in Column 1 of the Schedule annexed hereto.
- 4. Number, Classification, and Scale of Pay: The number of posts, their classification, and the scale of pay attached to them shall be specified in columns 2 to 4 of the said Schedule.
- 5. Method of recruitment, probation and promotion: The method of recruitment to the Service, the period of probation, and the lower grades from which promotion would be made, shall be

as indicated in columns 5 to 13 of the Schedule and Appendix I and Appendix II to these rules.

 - (b) Each paper will carry 100 marks.
- The standard and syllabus of the examination shall be such as the P&T Board may specify from time to time.
- The P&T Board may, in its discretion, fix such minimum qualifying marks in any or all of the subjects of the examination as it may deem fit.
