**Sub: "Project Tarang"- Telecom solution to Income tax Department to
Department of Income Tax- reg. roll out by 5th Nov, 2010**

This is in reference to this office letter even number dated 27th Oct, 2010 and letter number 10-8/2009-P&P-CM dated 25th Oct, 2010 (both available on Intranet). The circles were requested to be prepared for roll out of services at notice of 24 hours. In this connection it is intimated that the services to Income tax Department are to be rolled out by 5th Nov, 2010. (Letter enclosed)

The letters from Income Tax department has also been issued by their units. The same has already been uploaded on intranet. Along with these letter kindly get in touch with the ITD, Nodal officer and get the scheme implemented.

Blackberry handsets are already available with GM-EB (NCR-II) at Delhi, therefore, it is requested to immediately get handsets collected from GM-EB (NCR-II), Netaji Nagar, New Delhi so as the same could be made over to ITD officers before 5th Nov, 2010. However, 3G datacards are to be arranged by respective circles. 3G data cards 8000 in number have been procured centrally and are available with GM EB-I (NCR-II). Circles are required to allot 3G datacards from their own stocks. However, if required circles may recoup their stock by fetching the same quantity from GM EB-I (NCR-II).

CGM NTR is nodal authority for this account and shall be responsible for raising consolidated bill and collecting payment on biannually basis as lumpsum payment from Income Tax Department. Finance unit of corporate office shall issue separate instructions.

The service delivery to the customer is to be completed by 5th Nov, 2010 positively.
