OFFICE-MEMORANDUM

Subject: Pay fixation in IDA pay scale- clarification.

The undersigned is directed to say that a number of references are being received from various CCA offices as to how pay is to be fixed in IDA pay scales in respect of absorbed officials of BSNL who were promoted prior to 1.10,2000 but opted under FR 22 (I) (a) (i) for fixation of his pay in the promoted scale on the date of their next increment in the lower grade which fall after 1.10,2000.

The matter has been examined in this department and it is clarified that pay in such cases is to be fixed as under:-

- (i) Since, they were holding the promoted post substantively and drawing pay in the promoted scale on 1.10.2000, their pay on the date in the IDA pay scale will be fixed on point to point basis with references to pay drawn by them in the promoted CDA pay scale;
- (ii) On the date of accrual of increment in the lower CDA pay scales, their pay will again be fixed in the promoted CDA pay scales under FR 22(1)(a)(i) after adding the due increment in the lower CDA pay scale as per their option; and
- (iii) Thereafter, their pay in IDA pay scale will again be re-fixed on point to point basis with reference to above re-fixed pay in the promoted CDA pay scale as per their option.

A Model Calculation Sheet citing an example is enclosed for reference as Annexure-I.



OFFICE - MEMORANDUM

Subject: Method of pay fixation in IDA pay scale in respect of absorbed officials of BSNL who were promoted prior to 1/10/2000 but opted under FR22(I) (a) (i) for fixation of their pay in the promoted scale on the date of their next increment in the lower grade which falls after 1/10/2000

This department issued OM No. 1-1(1)/06-PAT dated 12/9/2006 on the method of pay fixation in IDA pay scale in respect of absorbed officials of BSNL who were promoted prior to 1/10/2000 but opted for fixation in the promoted scale on the date of their next increment in the lower grade under FR22(I) (a) (i), which falls after 1/10/2000. Thereafter a number of references were received from various Controllers of Communication Accounts expressing their observations and seeking further clarification on the issue.

The case was re-examined in consultation with the nodal department of PSUs i.e. Department of Public Enterprises. The Department of Public Enterprises has clarified that "The option of fixing the pay from the next increment date available under FR 22 will not be available for the employees of BSNL since their status changed on 1.10.2000. Hence, their pay will have to be fixed on the date of their promotion as per then existing rules prior to 1/10/2000 and no re-fixation can be permitted on the next increment date which is falling after 1/10/2000."

Therefore, in supersession of this department's OM No. 1-1(1)/06-PAT dated 12/9/2006, the undersigned is directed to say that the pay of the absorbed employees of BSNL who were promoted prior to 1/10/2000 but opted for fixation in the promoted scale on the date of their next increment in the lower grade under FR22(I) (a) (i), which falls after 1/10/2000, may be re-fixed in IDA pay scale as per the above clarification of the Department of Public Enterprises.

This issues with the concurrence of the Telecom Finance, vide their Diary No.-280/ADG(F)/08 dated 5/12/2008.

Sub: Guidelines regarding recovery of excess / wrongful payments made to employees of BSNL.

Sir,

In continuation of this office letter of even number dated 09.09.2016 on the subject cited above, it is intimated that it has been further clarified by DOT that in cases where there is no liability of Government of India insofar as payment of pay and allowances are concerned, no approval of Department of Telecommunications / Department of Expenditure for waiver of recovery of overpayment on account of pay and allowances earlier paid to BSNL employees is required. A copy of DOT letter No.2-49(04)/2016-PAT dated 07.11.2016 is enclosed in this regard. In view of this, this office letter dated 09.09.2016 stands modified accordingly.

Wherever waiver of recovery is considered necessary in the light of the decision of Hon'ble Supreme Court, the proposal giving full justification and expenditure involved alongwith recommendation of HOC and Circle IFA may be sent to the concerned cadre controlling branch in BSNL Corporate Office who would process the case in consultation with the Establishment Branch and convey the approval of the competent authority.

Sir,

Please refer to BSNL (HQ)'s Note on file No. 4-3/2016-PAT (B) on the subject noted above.

- The issue involved in the aforesaid two cases is regarding method of pay fixation in IDA Pay Scale of absorbed employees of BSNL, who were promoted prior to 01.10.2000 but opted under FR-22 (1) (a) (i) for fixation of their pay in promoted scale on the date of their next increment in the lower grade that fell after 01.10.2000. This method of pay fixation of BSNL absorbees was first permitted, vide DoT's OM No.1-1(1)/06-PAT dated 12.09.2006, which was subsequently disallowed, vide OM dated 17.12.2008, on DPE's instructions. Thus, the resultant over payment to the BSNL employees on this account pertained to the pay and allowances, which were recovered from their Death-cum-Retirement Gratuity at the time of their retirement and no amount of retirement benefits is involved in these recoveries.
- 3. It has been pointed out by the BSNL (HQ) in their note under reference that there is no liability of Government of India insofar as payment of pay and allowances are concerned. Since over payment in these cases has arisen on account of pay and allowances earlier paid to BSNL employees, no approval of Department of Telecom/Department of Expenditure for their waiver is required and the BSNL (HQ) may take a decision thereon on its own about challenging the orders of Hon'ble CAT or otherwise.

4. This issues with the approval of Member (S), DoT.
