After a comprehensive deliberation, NEC resolved to fight for the following vital issues-</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. To stop privatization of CPSEs. 2. Removal of affordability condition for pay revision of CPSE employees & implementation of 3rd PRC in all CPSEs 3.
